Suirbhé ar Staid na Gaeilge i Maigh Cuilinn

Tuarascáil ar an suirbhé a rinne Craobh Mhaigh Cuilinn de Chonradh na Gaeilge i gcomhar le Forbairt Pobail Mhaigh Cuilinn Teo. chun eolas a bhailíú mar chuid de phlean chun úsáid na Gaeilge a mhéadú sa pharóiste.

Cúlra

Tá Gaeilge á labhairt i Maigh Cuilinn leis na mílte bliain agus tá saibhreas ag baint leis an gceantar de bharr na teanga agus is rud é a thugann féiniúlacht faoi leith don pharóiste.

Baineann buntáistí áirithe le stádas Gaeltachta an pharóiste, don duine aonair agus don phobal trí chéile. Is fior le rá freisin go bhfuil an-chuid tugtha ar ais ag Maigh Cuilinn don Ghaeltacht agus do chultúr na tíre trí chéile, ach go háirithe i gcúrsaí litríochta. Is fior le rá freisin gur ceangal casta é atá idir Maigh Cuilinn agus Gaeltacht Chonamara agus neart ann a deir nár chóir dúinn a bheith sa Ghaeltacht ar chor ar bith agus nach bhfuil aon Ghaeilge i Maigh Cuilinn. Níl sé seo fior ar ndóigh. Ní ionann Maigh Cuilinn agus Ros Muc ó thaobh úsáid na Gaeilge ach ní ionann é ach oiread le aíteanna lasmuigh den Ghaeltacht.

Tá ceantair fós i Maigh Cuilinn ina bhfuil an Ghaeilge á labhairt gan sos leis na mílte bliain. Tá clanna á dtógáil le Gaeilge agus tá líon mór daoine a labhraíonn an teanga go rialta. An orthu atá an lucht nach bhfuil polasaí stáit ann maidir le cúrsaí pleánala agus forbartha teanga?

Chun cur ar ár gcumas pleán forbartha teanga a ullmhú bheartaigh Cr. Mhaigh Cuilinn de Chonradh na Gaeilge, i gcomhar le Cumann Forbartha Mhaigh Cuilinn, suirbhé a dhéanamh ar staid na Gaeilge sa pharóiste.

Survey on the Irish Language in Moycullen

Report on the survey conducted by Conradh na Gaeilge in conjunction with MCDA to collect information as part of a plan to increase the use of the Irish language in Moycullen.

Background

Irish has been spoken in Moycullen for thousands of years and the area has been greatly enriched by the language and it has given a distinct identity to the parish. Certain advantages accrue due to being in the Gaeltacht, both personal and community advantages. Moycullen has made its own contribution to the Gaeltacht and indeed the culture of the country in general particularly true in terms of literature. It is also true that the relationship between Moycullen and the Connemara Gaeltacht is a complicated one. Many would claim that the area should not be in the Gaeltacht at all and that there is no Irish spoken in the parish. This, however, is untrue. While Moycullen could not be compared to Ros Muc in terms of use of the language, neither can it be compared to areas outside the Gaeltacht.

There are still parts of Moycullen where Irish is the daily language as it has been without disruption for thousands of years. Families are being reared through Irish and there is a large number of people who use Irish on a daily basis. Is it their fault that the state does not have a policy for language planning and promotion?

To enable the preparation of a language plan for Maigh Cuilinn, the Maigh Cuilinn branch of Conradh na Gaeilge and MCDA carried out this survey on the position of the Irish language in the parish.

Cur Chuige

Scaipeadh ceistneoirí ar gach teach i bparóiste Mhaigh Cuilinn le linn mhí Eanáir – Mártá 2007 agus bailíodh na ceistneoirí ina dhiaidh sin. Ansin rinneadh torthaí na gceistneoirí a ionchur i mbunachar sonraí chun analís a dhéanamh orthu.

Gearrthuairisc

Bailíodh ceistneoirí ar ais ó 572 teach mar chuid den staidéar seo le 1,907 duine ar fad san áireamh sna ceistneoirí. Ó thaobh úsáid na Gaeilge, is é an toradh is suntasaí nó go ndeir 22.38% go labhraíonn siad Gaeilge sa bhaile ar bhonn laethúil. Go deimhin nuair a fhágann tú na daoine nár fhreagair an cheist seo as an áireamh ardaíonn an figiúr seo go dtí 25.4%. Léirítear bá láidir leis an teanga, fiú i measc daoine gan Ghaeilge agus daoine atá i ndiaidh bogadh isteach sa pharóiste. Arís, ag cur daoine nár fhreagair an cheist as an áireamh, tá 92% den phobal ag iarraidh go mbeadh stádas Gaeltachta ag Maigh Cuilinn. Léirítear an bá seo freisin maidir le úsáid na Gaeilge i gcomharthaíocht agus ainmneacha eastait 'srl. Is díol suntais é freisin an lín daoine atá i bhfabhar oideachais trí Ghaeilge.

Tá eolas luachmhar bailithe i dtaobh patrúin úsáide na teanga agus freisin maidir le tuairimí an phobail i dtaobh cur chun cinn na teanga agus na réimsí gníomhaíochta atá á lorg acu. Chun tosaigh anseo tá imeachtaí óige, an Ghaeilge sa chóras oideachais, úsáid na Gaeilge i siopaí agus gnónna agus ócайдí chun deis a thabhairt do dhaoine an Ghaeilge a úsáid.

Léirítear freisin na hathruithe atá ag tarlú sa pharóiste agus an gá gníomhú ar bhonn práinneach muna bhfuil an pobal láidir Gaeilge atá sa pharóiste le bheith báite de réir mar atá an daonra ag fás as éadan.

Methodology

Questionnaires were distributed to all houses in the parish during January-March 2007 and were duly collected. The returns were inputted into a database to allow them to be analysed.

Executive Summary

Questionnaires were returned from 572 houses encompassing 1,907 people in total. In terms of language usage the most striking feature is that 22.38% of respondents speak Irish on a daily basis in their homes. Indeed when the people who did not reply to this question are excluded the figure rises to 25.4%. There is a strong affinity for the language evident in the survey, including people with little fluency in the language and people who have recently moved into the area. Again, when the people who did not respond to the question are excluded, 92% want Moycullen to retain its Gaeltacht status. This affinity is evident also from the support for Irish language signage, housing estate names etc. The level of support for Irish language education is also significant.

Valuable information is also collected regarding language use patterns and also public opinion regarding the promotion of the language and the areas in which movement and activities are required. Chief among those are youth orientated activities, the teaching of Irish in schools, language use in shops and business, and events to provide people with the chance to speak Irish.

The study also tracks the changes that are happening in the parish and the need for immediate radical activity if the strong Gaeltacht community is not to be drowned in the ongoing population explosion.

An Chéad Chéim Eile

Caithfear plean Forbartha Gaeilge a ullmhú do Mhaigh Cuilinn anois láithreach. Tá todhchaí Ghaeltacht Mhaigh Cuilinn ag brath orainn féin mar phobal ar ndóigh, ach caithfear tacaíocht stáit a chur ar fáil chun an pobal a chumasú. Is díol suntais é an easpa tacaíochta don Ghaeilge i Maigh Cuilinn óna háisíneachtaí stáit le freagracht na Gaeilge. Tá cur chun cinn na Gaeilge i Maigh Cuilinn go dtí seo ag brath go príomha ar an earnáil dheonach. Caithfear maoiniú a chur ar fáil anois chun foireann lánimseartha a fhostú le plean Gaeilge a fheidhmiú agus freisin chun na híséanna eile atá ag teastáil a chur ar fáil.

Buíochas

Is mian linn buíochas a ghabháil le gach duine a ghlac páirt sa suirbhé agus go háirithe iad siúd a chuir an stró orthu féin moltaí agus tuairimí faoi leith a nochtadh. Beidh aird á tabhairt orthu seo ar fad. Is mian linn freisin buíochas a ghabháil le baill Chonradh na Gaeilge Mhaigh Cuilinn agus Baill Fhorbairt Pobail Mhaigh Cuilinn Teo. a rinne na ceistneoirí a dháileadh agus a bhailiú. Freisin tá buíochas ag dul do Niamh Mackin agus Helena Pidgeon san Oifig Phobail.

Cuirfidh Conradh na Gaeilge fáilte roimh aon duine gur mian leis a bheith páirteach in imeachtaí trí Ghaeilge nó atá ag iaraidh aon ghné de cheist na Gaeilge a phlé linn. Is féidir teagmháil a dhéanamh le:

Next Step

An action plan for the Irish language in Moycullen must be prepared immediately. While the future of the Moycullen Gaeltacht depends on the people of Moycullen, assistance must be provided to empower the community. To date the support for the Irish language in Moycullen from the state agencies with responsibility for the language has been practically non-existent. The promotion of the language in Moycullen has depended predominantly on the voluntary sector. Funding must now be provided to enable the employment of permanent staff to implement an Irish language plan and also to provide the other resources necessary.
